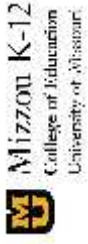
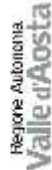

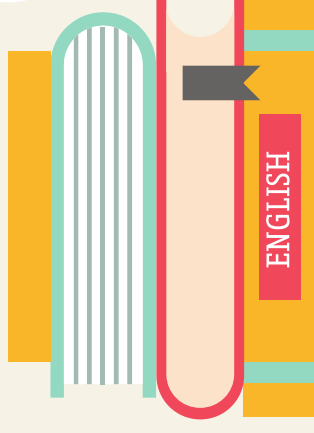

HOW TO REGISTER...

Schools need to download the application form from www.hippo-olympiad.org, complete it and send it to info@hippo-olympiad.org.

Candidate registrations are made online.

School coordinators will receive their username and password for the Hippo online registration platform (SOA). Instructions on how to use SOA are part of the Olympiad regulations document.
